As we near the March 5, 2024 election, I am writing to provide an update on my campaign for San Joaquin County Superior Court Judge. I am running to make our county a safer and more welcoming place to live, work and raise a family, and to continue to give back to the community that has given me so much. I have been a criminal prosecutor in the San Joaquin County District Attorney's office for over 15 years and supervise the Gang and Human Trafficking units. I have also served as an interim supervisor of the Homicide/Cold Case units. I currently chair the San Joaquin County Gang Task Force and serve on the California District Attorneys Association Grand Jury Committee and statewide working group for the Racial Justice Act. In December 2023, I received the "Court Employee of the Year" Award from the San Joaquin County Probation Officers Association.

I am proud to have been endorsed by District Attorney Ron Freitas, Sheriff Pat Withrow, and the San Joaquin County Deputy Sheriff's Association. I also have the support of law enforcement and first responders throughout the county including the Stockton Professional Firefighters Association, the Lodi Professional Firefighters Association, and the Police Officer Associations of Stockton, Lodi, Lathrop, Manteca, and Ripon. Additionally, I am endorsed by the California Association of Highway Patrolmen and the Peace Officers Research Association of California (PORAC), which is the largest law enforcement organization in California and the largest statewide association in the nation, along with many local county and city office holders. I am further endorsed by the founders of the Victims of Violent Crime and advocates who work with those harmed by violence. In addition to my work as a Supervising Deputy District Attorney, I also serve on several nonprofit and municipal boards, including the Lodi Public Library Board of Trustees, the board of the People Assisting the Lodi Animal Shelter, and St. Anne's School Advisory Council. I am the proud mother of two and a wife; daughter of a Purple Heart veteran; second-generation Puerto Rican woman; and a parishioner and lector at St. Anne's Catholic Church. From my direct experience in this county and courthouse, I believe our system of justice and laws are meant to work fairly and require each of us to believe in the rule of law and human dignity. As a Superior Court Judge, I would be honored to continue my service to our community with the professionalism, and even temperament each person and case deserves.
